Notes

1. Judy's mother, Margaret Catalane Devaney, recalled hearing that Charles Albert Catalani was a Captain in the Italian Army; that he came from Florence; that his two maiden sisters would not come to America because it was too barbaric, and so remained in Florence. We don't know if the sisters were older or younger than Charles. Charles had a millinery business in Newark from the time he came to America (about 1870) until he retired, shortly before his death.

J. Charles A. Catalani's age was given as 28 on his 27 Oct. 1874 marriage records, 32 on the 1 Jun. 1880 US Census, 50 on the 1 Jun. 1900 U.S. Census, and 58 on his 17 Apr. 1905 death certificate. In summary, he was born circa 1845-1850. Great-grandson Ray Michaels recalls hearing that Charles A. Catalani was born in Lucca.
