

Charles A. Catalani records history

Birth:

age 28 on 27 Oct. 1874 in Newark, NJ, St Patricks marriage register, so b. 1845-1846.

age 32 on 1 Jun. 1880 in US Census record, so b. 1847-1848, b. Italy.

age 50 on 1 Jun. 1900 in US Census record, so b. 1849-1850, b. Italy.

age 58 on 17 Apr. 1905 in Newark, NJ, death certificate, so b. 1846-1847.

Summary: b. 1845-1850, Italy (we think Lucca)

1870 US Census: We haven't found him in this census. Apparently he arrived in the U.S. some time after this census was taken.

1874-10-27: NJ Marriage Returns, Newark, 1874, on microfilm at the NJ State Archives, Trenton. Marriage No. 459, Octo. 27 [1874], Charles Catalani, of Newark, age 28, son of Alexander & Angaline; and Elizabeth Kehoe, of Newark, age 23, dau. of Peter & Eliza; married in Newark by Geo. H. Doane, clergyman of Newark. No occupation was listed for either groom or bride.

Charles immigrated in 1870, lived in U.S. for 30 years, and was a naturalized U.S. citizen. He owned his
home, which was mortgaged. All who worked had not missed any months of work in the past year. Charles

and William attended school 10 months, All could read and write. There are annotations in Charles's row which I believe pertain to a check of his naturalization record: 7-1 / Pg 7, and 5C.
