Further notes:

1. Julia Botwin, age 79 on 8 May 1902, of Keene, NH, was an aunt of Benj. Nedow, the soldier.<sup>M</sup>
2. Dates in Holden Town Hall birth records seem to be off by +1 year frequently, and names appear distorted.<sup>S</sup>
3. Spelling was very fluid in the 1800's and before, for this family and many others, whether French-Canadian or not. Many people could not spell, so it was up to the recorder to spell the names, based on how it sounded to him. This complicates analysis of the records, but it also informs us of how the names were pronounced.
4. Catholic children, French-Canadian and world-wide, were very often christened with an obligatory first name of Joseph, Jean-Baptiste, or Marie, added by the priest. The name by which they went was usually the last forename before the surname(s).
